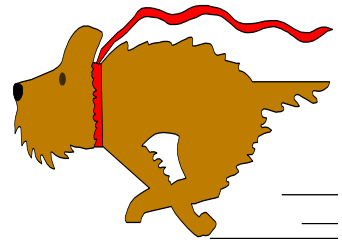


# Redgates Agility Club



## Club Rules

You must clean up after your dog, and take it (and any other rubbish) home with you.

Any dogs that show aggression to other dogs or to people may be asked to leave.

Any handlers that show aggression towards any dog or other people will be asked to leave.

All dogs must be kept under close control at all times, and must be kept on the lead unless instructed otherwise by a Redgates Trainer. Dogs must not use the equipment unless under the direct supervision and instruction of a Redgates Trainer.

Redgates Agility Club has all appropriate insurances, and the safety of handlers & dogs will always be put first. However, by attending classes organised by Redgates Agility Club, all handlers accept that Redgates Agility Club, its trainers, and the owners of the training venue are not responsible for any injury, damage, or other loss, howsoever caused.

### Do's:

- Wear sensible clothing (several layers) - it could be cold and wet;
- Wear training shoes, ideally with rubber or plastic studs;
- If there is any doubt about the class being held due to bad weather, telephone to check before you leave home;
- Bring treats or a toy for your dog with you;
- If you have any questions, please stop us and ask;

### Don'ts:

- If your dog is in anyway ill or injured, do not come to class;
- Bitch's in season must not be brought to the Training Venue;
- Never do Agility with your dog wearing a slip lead, or choke chain, or half-choke collar;
- No Dogs other than those registered with Redgates should be brought to the Training Venue;
